

**Tribal Leadership Certificate Program
2015-2016 Academic Year**

The Tribal Leadership Certificate Program is a partnership with Southwestern Michigan College that supports the educational journeys of Pokagon Citizens and employees of Pokagon organizations through a cohort program covering Tribal leadership and development. Those interested who are working for Tribal Government or interested in future tribal government employment can take advantage of this new program that will study Tribal sovereignty, Potawatomi culture, and the intricacies of Tribal law and government-to-government relationships.

The Certificate is a 28 credit business management career pathway program that is designed to be completed in a 2-2-1 course sequence. The first cohort will begin in the Fall Semester 2015. The academic year will include the following courses:
