**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF FINAL CANNABIS REGULATIONS**

In accordance with Subsection 3.03(e) of the Cannabis Regulatory Act (“Act”), the Cannabis Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) provides public notice of adoption of the attached final Cannabis Regulations (“Final Regulations”).

The Commission intends for the Final Regulations to be consistent with the Act, including by protecting the public health, safety, and welfare in a manner substantively similar to State Law and ensuring that the regulatory and enforcement systems align with the “Guidance Priorities”, as defined in the Act.

Broadly, the Final Regulations supplement the Act by establishing additional requirements relating to: (1) Cannabis Tracking Systems; (2) Cannabis Facility Licenses; (3) Cannabis Supplier Licenses; (4) Cannabis Employees; (5) Cannabis Operations; (6) Safety; (7) Designated Consumption Areas; and (8) Hearing Procedures.

This notice does not include a description of the nature and effect of the Final Regulations because the Final Regulations are the initial Final Regulations proposed by the Commission (consisting of 55 pages), rather than an amendment to existing Regulations. Additionally, the nature and effect of the Final Regulations is set forth in the plain language of the Final Regulations.

In accordance with Subsection 3.03(e) of the Act, the Commission has distributed and published with this Notice a Written Record of Consideration of Comments Regarding Cannabis Regulations, which includes relevant comments and the Commission’s responses to such comments.

In accordance with Subsections 3.03(a) and (e) of the Act, the Commission caused this public notice to be: (1) published on the Pokagon Band’s website; (2) emailed to the Tribal Council Secretary; and (3) emailed to the General Counsel. Additionally, the Commission caused this public notice to be emailed to legal counsel for Ember Enterprises, LLC., which will be pursuing a Cannabis Facility License.
