Amended Pokagon Band Gaming Commission Liquor Control Regulations

Notice of Intent

- **Description of the Nature**
 - Changes to the PBGC Liquor Control Regulations have been made to comply with relevant sections of the recently enacted Compact between the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians and the State of Indiana, clarify hours and days of alcoholic liquor sales, service, and consumption on licensed premises within the Michigan Reservation and Indiana Reservation, align the terms used in the PBGC Liquor Control Regulations to terms used in the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians of Michigan and Indiana Liquor Control Code, and clarify the rules of procedure for Commission hearings.
- **Effect of the Proposed Regulations**
 - The amended language contained in the PBGC Liquor Control Regulations clearly distinguishes between permitted activity related to alcoholic liquor sales, service, and consumption on licensed premises within the Michigan Reservation and Indiana Reservation, aligns the Regulations with relevant sections of the recently enacted Compact between the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians and the State of Indiana, aligns terminology in the Regulations with like terms used in the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi Indians of Michigan and Indiana Liquor Control Code, and specifies the rules of procedure for Commission hearings
